- The "Electromagnetic Compatibility" Directive (EMC) placed in the EMC harmonised standards **13/05/2016**
- Revocation: Directive 2004/108/EC is revoked with effect from 20 April 2016
- Entry into force and application 20/04/2016
- Machinery Directive 2006/42/EC, revised in harmonized standards of the Machinery Directive of 15/01/2016.
 Protection from various risks of an electrical, mechanical, chemical, thermal, etc. nature.
- Ministerial Decree of 21/03/1973" D.M. no. 220 of 26/04/1993 and subsequent amendments, of the Ministry of Health: Regulation incorporating an update to the decree of the Minister of Health 27/07/2016 concerning the "Hygiene discipline for the packaging of food products.
- RoHS Directive: restriction on the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical products. The RoHS Directive 2 (2011/65/EU): Has become compulsory from 1 July 2006. New obligations for the evaluation and declaration of compliance and mandatory CE marking.

Whoever produces must declare the compliance of the electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) with the RoHS Directive 2 and affix the CE marking.

 It also declares that all models of the floats produced by the FAES Company are products that have been tested with the harmonized standards (EN 60730-2-15:2010 EN 60730-1:2000/A2:2008) As is identified from TUV certificate p.2.
